Meetings: Guest speakers address about half of the meetings. Recently the owner of an avionics repair station, a retired flight test engineer from Edwards AFB, and the pilot of an around-the-world floatplane flight appeared before the members. The group has plenty of time for hangar flying and the all-important coffee and donuts during each meeting.

In June, the chapter meets outside to look at member's airplanes. Due to the Arlington Fly-in, no meeting occurs in July. In August, the annual picnic takes place; September is "Plans, Pictures and Parts" night while October brings the annual auction of members' surplus parts and tools. The year ends with the Christmas banquet in December.

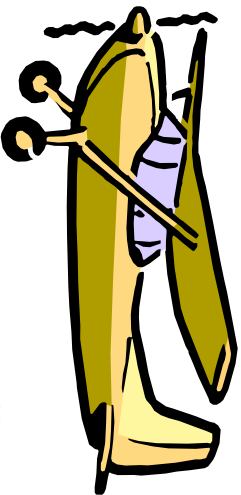
